The paramedic is expected to comply with the current Ambulance Act, BLS Patient Standards, ALS Patient Care Standards, Transportation Standards, Documentation Standards, Communicable Disease Standards, Regional Base Hospital Program medical directives and policies, the Highway Traffic Act, and other applicable legislation, policies and agreements.
